OTS Releases June Enforcement Statistics

WASHINGTON, D.C., August 5, 1998 -- The Office of Thrift Supervision (OTS) reported today that it completed six enforcement actions in June 1998.

This brings to 35 the number of enforcement actions by OTS since Jan. 1, 1998.

For the month of June 1998 there were:

- - 1 supervisory agreement.
- - 3 removal and/or prohibitions.
- - 1 cease and desist order.
